The Legends dart community in WA has now grown to over 500 players, we now have seven clubs with their own committees and their own monthly meetings, State Titles have been run for over ten years with attendances improving every year.

As with all successful clubs it is necessary to ensure each participant is aware of accepted behaviour required at each club meeting and venue. The following codes of behaviour aim to set out the minimum standards and should apply when playing or taking part in sanctioned activities.

- Show respect and courtesy to all involved with the sport. Treat each person as an individual.
- Act within the rules and spirit of the game.
- Promote fair play over winning at any cost.
- Respect the decisions of club officials and administrators. Abide by the policies and procedures and rules of the relevant club, state, and national body.
- Ensure your decisions and actions contribute to a harassment-free environment.
- Display appropriate and responsible behaviour in all interactions with your fellow dart players. Do not tolerate abusive, bullying, and threatening behaviour. Heckling is strongly discouraged, respect the rights of the dart players.
- Be appropriate and responsible in relation to alcohol, and other drugs.
- Act with integrity and accept responsibility for your decisions and actions.
- Do not attend venues with your own alcohol as it is strictly against liquor licence laws. Any person flouting liquor licence laws will be asked to leave immediately by the committee and or officials.
- Visitors should be encouraged to follow these standards when attending events.
